Hotels within walking distance

Premier Inn Nottingham City centre (Chapel Bar) Hotel - 3 minutes walk.

Travelodge Nottingham Central - 7 minutes walk.

Crowne Plaza Nottingham - 5 minutes walk.

Hilton Nottingham, Milton Street - 10 minutes walk.





Getting HERE

Parking

If your hotel doesn't have parking then the local carpark is the NCP on Mount Street, which is less than 5 minutes walking distance from our venue. Venue staff have validation tickets available and currently the rate is £9.95 per 24h stay. You simply park first and then ask any of the staff for a validation ticket and you pay on departure from the car park.

By Air

The closest airport to the venue is East Midlands airport - approximately 14 miles away. Birmingham airport is approximately 49 miles away but may offer a greater range of flights.

By Rail

Nottingham Railway Station is 1.2 miles away, a 16 minute walk from the venue. With trains arriving from a range of major cities.



Alt Friendly **Bars**

The Pit & Pendulum

Alternative bar with a gothic vibe. Open daily from 12pm. Think hidden toilets behind bookshelves, swinging axes, dark yet classic decor. 7 deadly sins cocktails. The pit tends to be the quietest during the day. Worth a visit even just for the decor.

10 minute walk from the venue.

The Tap & Tumbler

Pub and live music venue. Mostly popular with the rock/metal crowds in the area. Open daily from 12pm till late. Food available.

3 minute walk from the venue.



Alt Friendly **Bars**

Ye Olde Salutation Inn

15th Century pub situated above Anglo-Saxon caves. Metal and alternative crowd. Really good little pub with lots to look at. Open daily from 10am, except Sundays when it opens at 12pm. There are hidden alcoves to sit in as well as an outside beer garden. Due to its age the floors are a little uneven with steps throughout. They have a vast selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks. Food is available at select times.

7 minute walk from the venue.

Rock City

Rock City has always been one of the best venues for smaller gigs in the UK. Awesome alternative venue with a big history. There are 3 rooms within rock city. During the week is a mix of live music and club nights. There is disabled access. A list of upcoming gigs can be found at HERE.

Alt Friendly Shops

Void

Your old traditional alternative shop. Selling everything from Gothic and band merch to vintage dresses and jewellery. Open every day from 11am. Void has always been my go to place when visiting Nottingham. If you like band t.shirts, baggy trousers, retro dresses, punk etc. they have you covered. 11 minute walk from the venue.

Forbidden Planet

Forbidden Planet is a well known geeky shop! Selling everything comic related, anime, pop vinyls, Lounge fly and loads more. Open daily from 10am, except Sunday which is 11am.

7 minute walk from the venue.

Ice Nine

Ice nine is in the same area as Void. Known as more of a hippy shop. They sell a wide selection of crystals as well as jewellery. There is a sex shop located in the basement, and they also sell smoking paraphernalia. Very eclectic mix of items, definitely worth checking out.

11 minute walk from the venue.



Vegan Friendly **Dining**

No.Twelve

Completely plant based restaurant offering a casual fine dining experience. A la Carte, lunch deals and tasting menus available. Plus they're dog friendly! 8 minutes walk from the venue.

Golden Fleece Kitchen

Serving Vegan food since 2019. A colourful plant based menu including burgers and a Sunday roast! Located in the Golden Fleece, Nottinghams only Vegan pub! 15 minutes walk from the venue.

Cafe Sobar

Whilst not a fully vegan eatery it does have a good selection available and caters for dietary requirements including a vegan full English Breakfast & Gluten Free cakes! It also a completely alcohol free bar, restaurant and venue.
